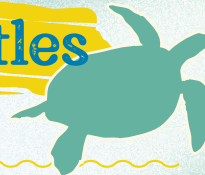

Help Us Learn about Sea Turtles in Texas Waters!



The Texas coast is home to 5 different species of sea turtles. Some sea turtles live offshore, while others live in the bays year-round, or for short periods of time. The most common sea turtle found in our bays is the green sea turtle, pictured on this card. Green sea turtles eat

seagrass and algae and are commonly found near the jetties or in the flats near seagrass meadows. We are studying the sea turtles in Texas bays, estuaries and Gulf of Mexico waters and we need your help to understand where they go and what places are important to them.

YOU CAN HELP BY TELLING US WHERE YOU SEE SEA TURTLES

- 1 Download the iSeaTurtle app for Android or iPhone.
- 2 Open the app, click "Send Location," and your current location will be shown on the map. If needed, move the map and place your location under the red cursor or select the bullseye. Then click "Submit."
